

## Our School

Our school has nationwide enrolment.

Many families have difficult financial backgrounds.

The pupils often see their independence constrained as the school daily contacts their parents.

The parents are quite passive.

Through the integration of parents into the school's educational life their responsibility grows.

Events aiming at the inclusion of parents into scholastic life:

At the onset of the school year a questionnaire is distributed. The school seeks to collect information regarding the realms in which parents may be of help (usually communal work).

Basing on the results, a databank is produced.

The parents financially support the foundation of the school.

Those who run an enterprise may make their contribution to vocational training by furthering the development of the school.

There are four parents' evenings, the law prescribes only two.

The Piarist congregation organises a special event – 'white-tilted table' – where parents, teachers and pupils may meet in a less formal environment. This event is organised separately for the individual age-groups.

Family getaways: once a year, pupils, their families, and their teachers (with their families) go hiking. Collective cooking and barbecue constitute a part of this event. The excursion is also carried out on the class-level.
